Sant Mirabai was a 16th Century mystic Poet and devotee of Lord Krishna. She is considered one of the most prominent and beloved figures in the Bhakti movement, a spiritual and social reform movement in medieval India. She composed numerous poems and songs expressing her deep longing for union with Lord Krishna
